Program Accomplishments

This year the Megan Meier Foundation has reached **42,900** students, parents, educators and professionals through school-based and community-based bullying and cyberbullying prevention and postvention programs.

Speaking Engagements

By showing the devastating effects of bullying, cyberbullying and suicide through Megan's story, audiences develop greater empathetic awareness and understanding of these issues. Tina's presentations spanned over **9** states reaching a total **35,254** students, parents, educators and professionals. **80.67%** of students felt like they benefited from hearing Megan's story. After hearing Megan's story, **88.04%** of middle and high school students felt as though they could better identify, or empathize, with other individuals impacted by bullying and cyberbullying.

EMPOWER Leadership Workshops

The Megan Meier Foundation has developed workshops designed to spread awareness, develop a firm knowledge base for students, and empower youth to be leaders against bullying within their own school and community. This year the Foundation has worked interactively with **209** middle – high school students and school sponsors at the **2** EMPOWER Leadership Workshops. Following the event, schools used Megan's Voice Action Plan to impact an additional **2,833** students. **95.7%** of middle and high school students learn something new by attending the EMPOWER workshop.

Resource Center

Due to the prevalence and detrimental impact of the issues surrounding bullying, the Megan Meier Foundation listens, supports, and refers struggling individuals and families. This year the Foundation worked with **118** individuals. **100%** of individuals assisted by the Resource Center agreed that they received information and resources that allowed them to take steps toward resolution.

In response to the 13 million children bullied every year, the Megan Meier Foundation assists schools and communities by providing bullying prevention and postvention strategies, resources, and support.
